This allows the Vienna Medical Center to host specialists for cardiology, internal medicine, neurology, surgery, neurosurgery, oncology, radiology, urology and others. External co-operation includes the fields of laboratory medicine, nuclear medicine, ENT, obstetrics / gynecology, ophthalmology, paediatrics and radio-oncology.

To ensure that patients have access to the best possible treatment that may not be available in Austria, the Vienna Medical Center has established a national and international network. This enables the team to utilise qualified second opinion referrals and to provide effective treatments such as cyberknife and proton therapy, which are among the latest developments in radio oncology (cancer treatments) and highly effective where appropriate. As the head of the medical center, Dr. Michael Zimpfer, MD, MBA, serves as



a full professor at the Vienna General Hospital, and has guided the career paths of many young physicians who have gone on to serve in positions in academia, clinical medicine and the pharmaceutical industry, in Austria, Europe and the U.S.

He himself started his career in pharmacology, was awarded a scholarship for cardiology at Harvard Medical School, returning to Austria to complete his thesis in anesthesiology and critical care and is an alumnus of the Chicago Graduate School of Business. He has a lifetime interest in the various interactions between medical disciplines and approaches his patients in a holistic and integrated manner.

One of his particular interests is pain management, providing the most developed non invasive and image-guided, minimal invasive pain treatments.
